BCCI participated in the Strategic Planning Workshop

On August 26, 2026, BCCI participated in the Strategic Planning Workshop: Advocating for Tobacco Control in Belize, held at the Inspiration Center in Belize City. The workshop brought together key stakeholders to discuss tobacco control efforts in Belize, the importance of advocacy, and strategies for strengthening tobacco control measures.

The workshop provided an overview of tobacco control in Belize, emphasizing the health and social impacts of tobacco use and the importance of continued advocacy, public awareness, and stronger policies. Participants gained insight into Belize's legislative process and how advocacy can support the development and implementation of effective tobacco control legislation. **CARICOM Needs Assessment Survey on Digital Trade
Readiness - Current and Aspiring MSME Exporters**

The CARICOM Regional Organisation for Standards and Quality (CROSQ), under the CARICOM Digital Trade Readiness (DTR) Project, is conducting a regional needs assessment to understand CARICOM stakeholders' awareness of and readiness for the European Union's emerging Digital Product Passport (DPP) requirements and related digital trade regulations.

This survey seeks to gather information on the awareness, capabilities, challenges, and support needs of micro, small, and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs) that currently export, or intend to export, products to the European Union (EU). For the purposes of this survey, micro enterprises employ fewer than 5 persons, small enterprises employ fewer than 25 persons, and medium enterprises employ between 25 and 50 persons.

The survey takes approximately 8-10 minutes to complete. All responses will be treated confidentially and reported only in aggregated form. The information collected will help inform recommendations and capacity-building initiatives to strengthen CARICOM's digital trade readiness.

AS A PRECAUTION, BUSINESSES ARE ENCOURAGED TO:



Verify unfamiliar clients, requests, and payment instructions independently.
Always confirm the identity and legitimacy of any request through trusted channels before taking action.



Maintain communication procedures for employees operating in remote locations.
Ensure regular check-ins and established protocols to verify requests and share information securely.



Confirm emergency claims through trusted contacts where possible.
Use known contact information to verify any urgent or unusual requests.



Avoid making urgent payments based solely on phone calls or messages.
Scammers often create a false sense of urgency to bypass normal verification.



Immediately report suspicious activity to the relevant authorities and financial institutions.
Early reporting can help prevent further incidents and protect other businesses.

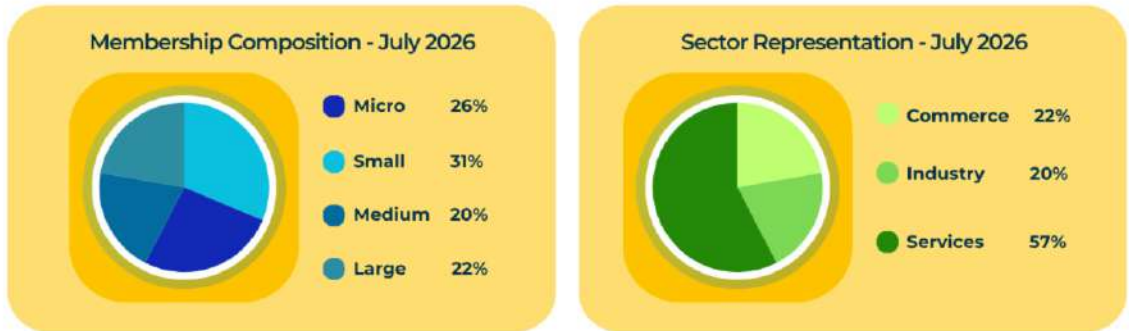
