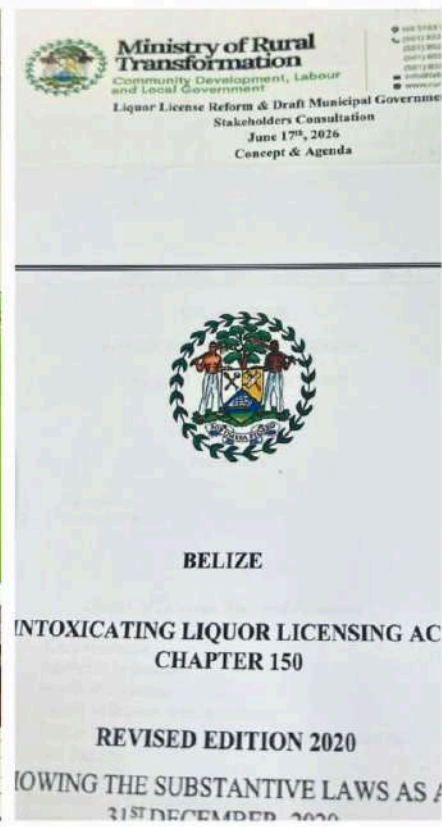


## **The Business of Governance: BCCI Outlines National Agenda**

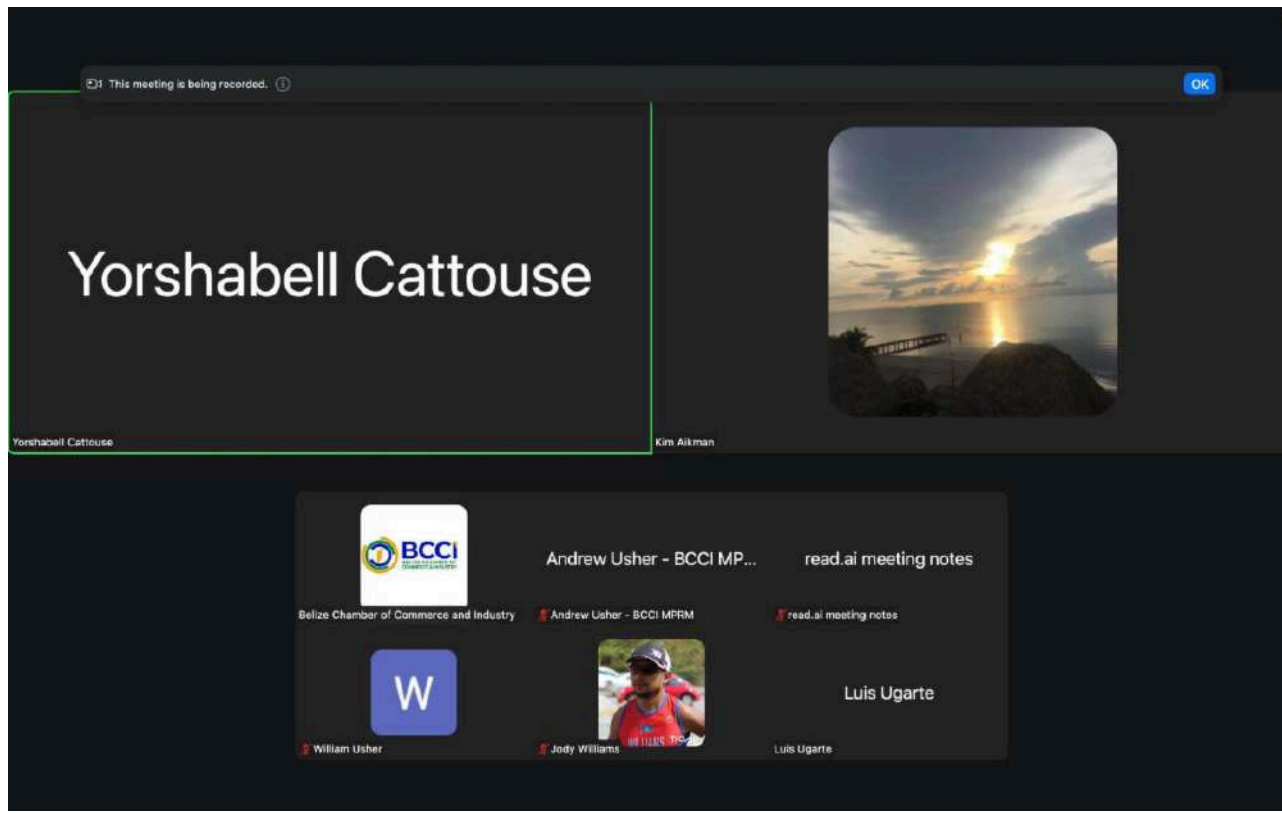
The consultation forms part of ongoing efforts to review and modernize the existing Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Act and to develop a Municipal Government Bill aimed at consolidating the currently fragmented laws governing municipalities. The workshop provided an opportunity for stakeholders to identify key challenges and gaps in the existing legislative frameworks and discuss opportunities for improvement and modernization.



## BCCI Participated in Climate Landscape Analysis for Children Plus Reference Group

On Thursday June 18th, Membership Programs Administrator, Ms Krystin Romero attended the **Climate Landscape Analysis for Children Plus (CLAC+)** report Reference group meeting, organized by the Ministry of Sustainable Development, Climate Change and Solid Waste Management, through the Sustainable Development Unit, in collaboration with UNICEF at Best Western Belize Biltmore Plaza Hotel.

The CLAC+ report analyses Belize's climate, environment, energy, and disaster risk (CEED) reduction landscape, focusing on how it impacts children while identifying key intervention areas to inform evidence-based policies. The group met to discuss and review the draft report with other key stakeholders.

### The Caribbean's Blue Economy Knowledge Now Has a New Home

Belize City, Belize (CRFM) – The Caribbean Regional Fisheries Mechanism (CRFM), in partnership with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), and the Development Bank of Latin America and the Caribbean (CAF), have officially launched an open-access, **Caribbean Blue Economy (BE) Knowledge Hub** that brings together decades of the region's expertise and insight on fisheries, aquaculture, and marine spatial planning.

### Exports from Latin America and the Caribbean Rise 15.7% in Early 2026, Extending Growth Trend

WASHINGTON — The value of goods exported from Latin America and the Caribbean grew by 15.7% year-on-year in the first quarter of 2026, building on 7.8% growth in 2025, according to the latest edition of "**Trade Trends Estimates – Latin America and the Caribbean**," a report by the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB). The increase reflects faster growth in both export volumes and prices. Regional export growth was driven primarily by mining products, particularly gold and copper, and strong performance in agribusiness products such as soybeans, coffee, and meat. Oil exports also contributed significantly.

Ensure regular check-ins and established protocols to verify requests and share information securely.



**Confirm emergency claims through trusted contacts where possible.**

Use known contact information to verify any urgent or unusual requests.



**Avoid making urgent payments based solely on phone calls or messages.**

Scammers often create a false sense of urgency to bypass normal verification.



**Immediately report suspicious activity to the relevant authorities and financial institutions.**

Early reporting can help prevent further incidents and protect other businesses.

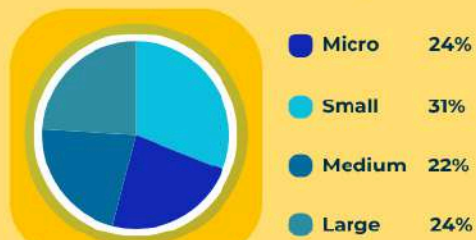
