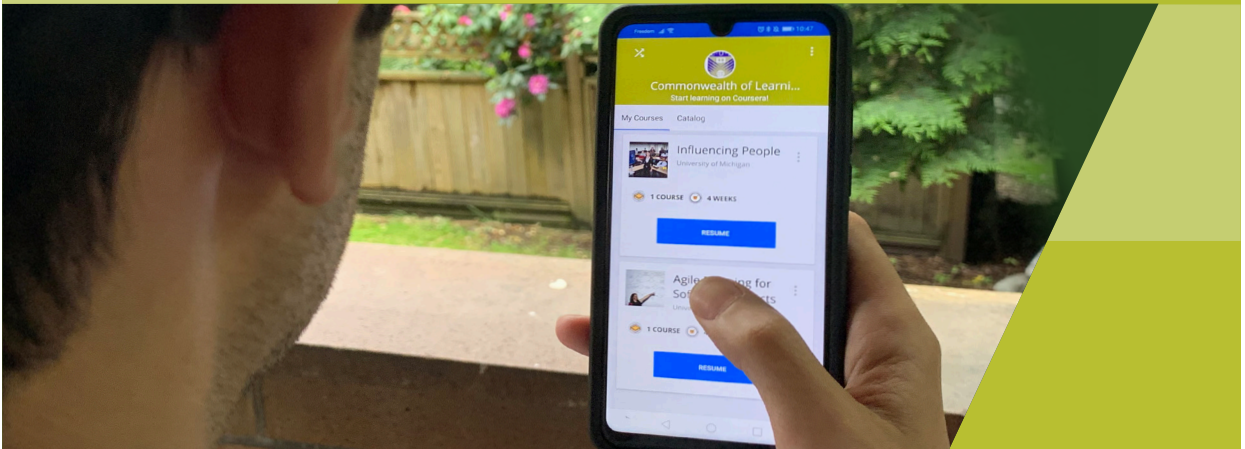

Experts located in the four regions of the Commonwealth will offer help with choosing courses, and provide administrative, academic support, as well as mentorship and counselling.

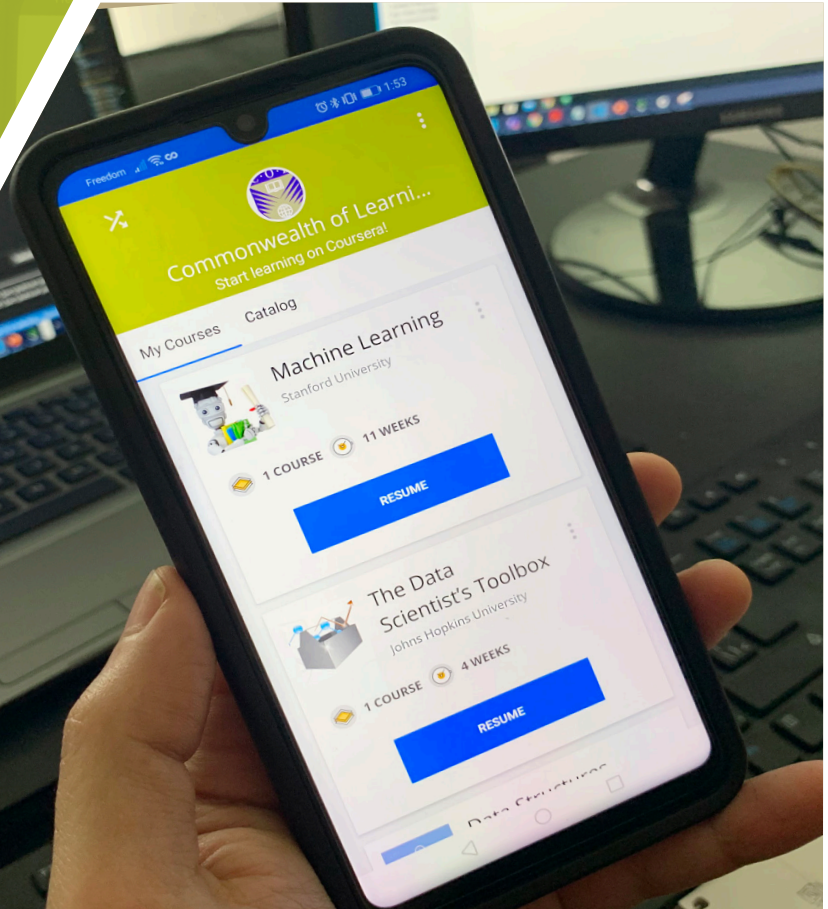
