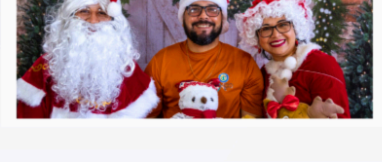
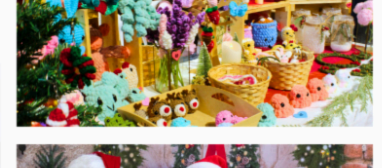
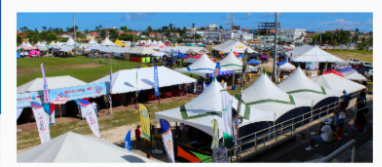

BCCI Hosts Strategic Meeting to Strengthen Belize–El Salvador Trade Relations

The Belize Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BCCI) was pleased to host a meeting on Monday, June 22, 2026, between BCCI President Mr. Giacomo Sanchez, CEO Mrs. Kim Aikman, and the Ambassador of El Salvador to Belize, H.E. Graciela Marina Pérez Zeledón.

Discussions centered on the upcoming signing of the Belize–El Salvador Partial Scope Agreement (PSA), which is expected to strengthen bilateral trade relations and expand market access opportunities for Belizean producers and businesses. 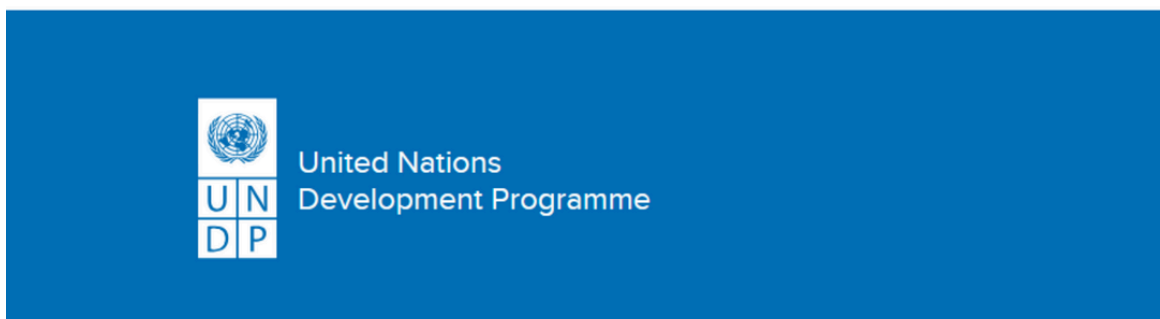

Members are encouraged to exercise caution when responding to unfamiliar service requests, urgent payment demands, suspicious phone calls, or communications requesting sensitive information or immediate financial transfers.

AS A PRECAUTION, BUSINESSES ARE ENCOURAGED TO:

-  **Verify unfamiliar clients, requests, and payment instructions independently.**
Always confirm the identity and legitimacy of any request through trusted channels before taking action.
-  **Maintain communication procedures for employees operating in remote locations.**
Ensure regular check-ins and established protocols to verify requests and share information securely.
-  **Confirm emergency claims through trusted contacts where possible.**
Use known contact information to verify any urgent or unusual requests.
-  **Avoid making urgent payments based solely on phone calls or messages.**
Scammers often create a false sense of urgency to bypass normal verification.
-  **Immediately report suspicious activity to the relevant authorities and financial institutions.**
Early reporting can help prevent further incidents and protect other businesses.

The Chamber encourages all members to remain alert and to share this advisory with relevant staff and management teams.

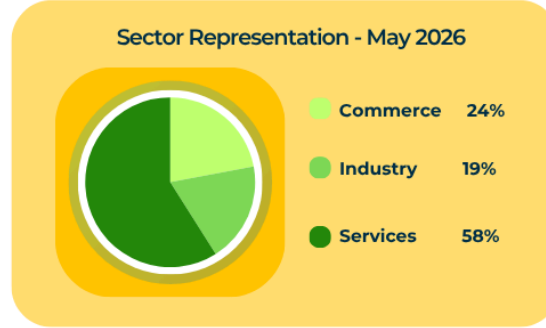
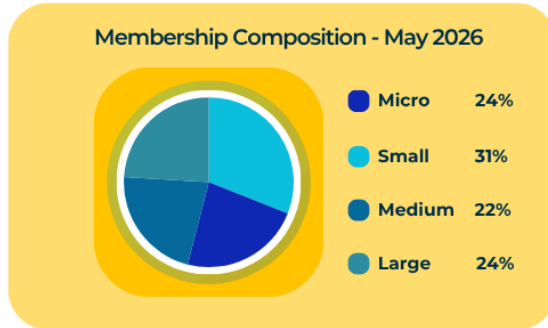
